Gun Show Policy

BACKGROUND

The Fort Colville Gun Club sponsors a semi-annual Gun Show in order to raise funds and promote membership. This policy is intended to clarify certain details of operation.

POLICY

The Gun Show Coordinator will be in charge of securing a venue, scheduling overnight security, fixing admission fees, table/space rent, and advertising.

If food and beverage service is desired, the Club will endeavor to support the 4H Group by allowing them to prepare, serve, and charge for food and/or beverages according to appropriate food service regulations


Vendor tables are available to both Club members and the public; the Coordinator will determine if wares are appropriate to the Club purpose. Members not wishing to rent a table may use a designated club table for up to two (2) items at one time.

Loaded firearms are not allowed at the Gun Show; on-duty Law Enforcement Officers are exempt.


Gun Show revenue shall be deposited to the Club general bank account. The Gun Show Coordinator and the Rifle Range Committee shall keep records verifying receipts and expenses.

EXECUTIVE BOARD APPROVAL


This policy is approved and adopted by the Executive Board effective January 9, 2014. Club bylaws require a quorum of at least four (4) members.






